1. WELCOME & GUESTS

- Dan Heltsley, president, welcomed everyone. Fifty-Seven (57) AD's in attendance.

2. SPECIAL AGENDA – League Alignments

- SPSL – 4A North will add Auburn and Auburn-Riverside, 4A South will add Decatur to make 2 divisions of 9. 3A division is currently 6 schools and has applications from Clover Park, Lakes and Peninsula for membership, North Thurston Schools may also apply for membership.
- Narrows – 4A League will lose North Kitsap and Shelton may enter
- WCC – Shelton is 4A and may leave, Peninsula is applying to league, Clover Park and Lakes have applied to SPSL 3A, North Thurston Schools may apply, still the possibility of a split 3A/4A league
- Seamount – Foster will join, possible 2A/3A split league as Evergreen, Tyee and Renton of the current schools have 2A numbers or they may opt up.
- Olympic 3A/2A will add North Kitsap, Peninsula may leave, Port Townsend is 1A but will stay to create a 3aA/2A/1A league.
- Nisqually 2A - Foster is leaving and the other 4 schools will stay
- Nisqually 1A – Seattle Christian may leave, other schools will remain in previous capacity

- North Olympic B – No change at this time

3. **JIM MEYERHOFF**

- The goal of the WIAA and WCD in league realignment is to accommodate all schools
- The WIAA Executive Board can mandate that a league accept the placement of a school in to a specific league
- Jim provided attendees with a Summary of 2008-2010 WIAA Classifications that can be found on the WIAA website
- December 14th is the opt-up deadline for schools. This deadline can be extended if requested to the WIAA
- District III allocations will be determined after all schools are set in a classification
- Multiple High School Districts require some additional calculations to determine enrollment as the information from OSPI is a total district enrollment. School Districts work with WIAA to break these numbers out and determine actual enrollments at schools.
- There is an appeal process for schools who find themselves in unusual circumstances in regards to classification. Appeals should be made to the WIAA by January 3, 2008 for consideration.
