

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Bands are not permitted at this event.
2. Only an official school banner (made of cloth or vinyl) will be permitted.
3. Artificial noisemakers of any kind are not permitted and may be confiscated by tournament supervisors or tournament staff.
4. Throwing confetti or other materials is not permitted.
5. The use of tobacco or tobacco products on Auburn School District property is prohibited.

TEAM BUSES & TEAM VANS:

All team bus and team van parking is located on the north side of the school building. **Buses must enter the campus via 124th Ave SE for a direct route to the “BUS ONLY” area.** See the driving directions on page 6 of this syllabus. Bus spaces #7 - #22 are reserved for the 16 teams on a first come basis after 3 PM. The team entrance is next to the main spectator entrance in the WEST COURTYARD. Signs will direct teams and spectators. The bus zone exit is at the east end of the one way bus zone on 132nd Ave SE. **All team buses must park in east or west lots until all school buses depart AMHS at 2:45 PM.**

SPECTATOR PARKING:

The primary spectator parking lots are at the west end of the campus near the 124th Ave entrance. The entrance to the gymnasiums is also at the west end of the building. There will be students parked in the west lots until 3 PM on Friday while school is in session. Additional parking can be found in the teachers' parking lots located at the east end of the building near the 132nd Ave entrance. To enter the tournament from the east parking lot, spectators must walk all the way around the building to the west courtyard and the event entrance.

TEAM ENTRANCE:

All players, coaches, and managers or trainers must enter the building through Pass Gate Entrance at the main entrance to the tournament located in the West Courtyard.

TEAM ENTRY:

Each team will be allowed a roster of 14 players and a combination of coaches and managers totaling 4. **These numbers are the same as the State Tournament. Only those listed on the official roster will be allowed on the playing floor or team bench.**

ROSTER & ELIGIBILITY:

Attached is a “Tournament Roster” form. This must be completed and returned ASAP so the tournament program may be prepared properly. Your Tournament Roster is due no later than the end of the day Monday, November 2, 2009. We prefer you send it via email to the Tournament Director Murray Johnson: mjohnson@auburn.wednet.edu. TRAINING ROOM:

The Auburn Mountainview training room will be open to provide ice for teams when requested. The training room is located in the short hall off the **500 Hall at the weight room**. You will need to provide your own athletic trainer, tape, and supplies. Student trainers will be available in the training room.

LOCKER ROOMS:

A locker room will be available to share on Friday and Saturday. On Friday, the girls' locker room will be the only one available. All day Saturday both locker rooms will be open and available to be shared by teams. The locker rooms are located in the short hall off the **500 Hall**, between the two gyms and opposite the fitness center & training room.

We will provide small team areas in the Commons starting after 4 PM on Friday with tables and chairs for each team. Team locations will be assigned with signs attached. You must use your assigned location.

TOWELS & PADLOCKS:

All teams must furnish your own towels. If you wish to leave anything in either locker room you must provide your own locks. The locker room doors will not be locked during the tournament to allow team access at all times.

PASSES:

Only WCD Executive Board, SWD Executive Board, WSCA & WSSAAA passes will be accepted. **Any others including League or Season Passes will not be accepted.**

PASS GATE & PASS LIST:

The pass gate will be next to the main ticket entrance. Administrators and Faculty who are on the pass list must be in the area your students are sitting in during matches. Your assistance is valuable and important in maintaining a positive sportsmanship like atmosphere at the tournament. Spectators wishing to leave and return for a later match will be stamped.

Your supervision pass list must be faxed or emailed to Murray Johnson, Tournament Director, no later than noon on Wednesday, November 4, 2009.

CHEERLEADERS:

Cheerleaders will be admitted through the pass gate only and must be in uniform. During matches officials and/or the Tournament Director will determine what areas are suitable for cheer squads. For the safety of everyone involved cheer squads must stay in the designated areas.

TEAM INTRODUCTIONS:

Team introductions will be made for the Championship game on Saturday only. All players and coaches for both teams will be introduced.

FILMING:

There are limited power outlets at each court. Bring extra batteries.

CONCESSIONS:

The concession stand in the Commons will be open during most of the tournaments hours. **Food and drinks are not allowed in the gyms. Water is allowed. Please remind parents and fans we will enforce the food policy strictly.** There will be a hospitality room for coaches and officials.

TOURNAMENT T-SHIRTS:

WCD / SWD Tournament T-Shirts are pre-sale only. Coaches must order by 10/30/09.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

2009 National Federation rules will be used with the following exceptions:

1. Each match will consist of 3 out of 5 games. The first four game to 25 and the fifth game to 15 with no cap.
2. Each team must furnish their own warm-up balls. Match balls will be furnished by the tournament manager.
3. All game officials, line judges and official scorekeepers will be furnished by the officials association.

OFFICIALS & SCORERS:

The Tournament director will arrange for officials from officiating boards located in District III & IV. These officials will serve as game officials, line persons, and scorekeepers. Assigning secretaries from each board represented determine all official assignments. One official will serve as the tournament official coordinator to be sure all matches assigned are covered by a full set of officials.

~~If both teams use a libero, the home team will provide a libero tracker at the scorer's table. If only one team uses a libero, that team must supply the libero tracker at the scorer's table.~~ The WCD will not supply a libero tracker. Although the scoreboards will be operated by tournament staff, they will not be the official score of the match.

As of 10/26/09 the WCD III **will provide** a libero tracker.

DESIGNATION OF HOME TEAM:

1. The home team will be the bottom team on each bracket.
2. The home team warms up first.

PRE MATCH WARM-UP:

The 5-5-2 warm-up will procedure will be followed. Home warms up first. There will be a twenty minute minimum time period between matches when teams are playing consecutive matches. **Teams should not arrive more than one hour before the first match of the day. Teams will be allowed on the courts starting at 1:20 PM on Friday and 9:20 AM on Saturday. Please remember AMHS will be in session on Friday when you arrive. We ask that you are patient allowing us time to set up your team tables after school is out and students have left the building.**

COURT ASSIGNMENTS:

Drawn by the West Central District/SW Volleyball Committee. The Tournament Director shall have the authority to make adjustments as deemed necessary.

Driving Directions to Auburn Mountainview High School

From the South, North, or West of Auburn:

EAST CAMPUS ENTRANCE

Take Highway 167 to Auburn, then take Highway 18 Eastbound. Exit at the 304th Street exit, (Pacific Raceways exit) turn right on 304th and proceed to the light at 132nd Ave SE. Turn right on 132nd Ave SE and proceed 1 mile. The east entrance to Auburn Mountainview High School will be on your left. The entrance to all gymnasium events is through the west courtyard at the west end of the building. Parking for gym events will also be at the west end of the building. Proceed past the front entrance to the school to get to the west parking lots and west entrance.

Westbound on Highway #18 use the 304th Street exit and follow the same directions as above.

WEST ENTRANCE - ATHLETIC EVENT ENTRANCE

All buses must use the 124th Ave. West Entrance to get to the “Bus Only” parking lot. Follow the signs straight to the north side of the building and the bus parking lot. The bus parking spaces are numbered from east to west (left to right), 1 – 22.

Follow the same basic directions as above to get to 132nd Ave SE. *As soon as you turn right onto 132nd Ave. SE you must turn left on 304th and proceed ½ mile to the Round-About at 124th Ave SE.* Turn right on 124th Ave. SE and proceed ¾ mile to the right turn lane and the **West Entrance** to Auburn Mountainview High School. It's easy to miss the entrance, proceed slowly. Once on campus stay to the right at the fork, event parking is to the right and left. **All buses and Team Vans proceed into the “Bus Only” entrance.** The entrance to the gymnasiums is in the West Courtyard between the two wings of the building.
